



Bhd. with his siblings in 2020 to further pursue his passion for film.

Some of Mohd Hanif Fikri Bin Jaafri's notable accomplishments include winning first place in the Vison PETRON Short Film competition in 2016 with the short film "Nyawa" and being honored as the Best Cameraman by Bernama in 2017 for the short film "Merdeka Di Mata Hati."


With an impressive six years of experience in the Creative & Film Making industry, he possesses a wide range of skills and expertise, including VFX, design, animation, editing, acting, video music, directing, and photography. His dedication to continuous learning and his aspiration to contribute to the production of high-quality films in Malaysia and the international market drive him forward. Currently, he holds the position of Director of Photography for a telemovie entitled "Tari Sama Bayu," scheduled to be aired on Hari Malaysia by Radio Television Malaysia (RTM). He is also involved in editing a travel log project for TV Sarawak (TVS).



Palani Veloo Subramaniam INMATES

Palani Veloo showcased his love for film arts by independently directing and producing short films since 2014. What started as a hobby for this talent with an engineering background soon became an opportunity to pursue his passion when he received the Special Jury Award for his short film "Apps" at the Panasonic Digital Short Film competition in 2016. To date, Palani has created nine short films, with his debut work titled "Memories." Although he considers it an amateur piece, his interest and personal voice shines through in the content he has created.





Throughout his filmmaking journey, Palani has embraced a guerrilla approach due to the self-funded nature of most of his projects. This approach has granted him the freedom to make mistakes and discover new ways to enhance his craft. These valuable experiences ultimately led him to create his latest work, "INMATES," which has been selected as one of the Top 10 finalists for the BMW Shorties in 2023.

Currently, Palani is in the early stages of developing a feature project, primarily focusing on research and writing. His goal is to advance his career as a director and continue sharing compelling stories that reflect his personal voice, with the hope of connecting with an audience who resonates with his work.

Chew Boon Wai 阿嬤 Ah Ma



Chew Boon Wai's journey in the industry began as a Director of Photography (DOP), gradually venturing into the realm of directing during his university days. Having a talent for directing and cinematography, Chew Boon Wai obtained a degree in Film and Broadcasting from the University of Science Malaysia (USM) and further honed his skills as an alumnus of the Asian Film Academy (AFA) through the Busan International Film Festival in 2018.


One of his notable creations is "Perhaps That Elephant is Still Asleep" (2021), a commissioned piece by the Taiwan Public Television Service that earned him the Grand Prize of the Next New Wave Award at the SeaShorts Film Festival in 2022. Additionally,

his films "Culture Shot" (2016) and "Lonesome" (2021) were featured at prestigious events such as the New York Jazz Film Festival and the Asian Queer Film Festival, respectively.

His dedication to the art of filmmaking is evident in his first narrative of storytelling as a writer-director, "阿嬷 Ah Ma". With a desire to further expand his repertoire, Chew Boon Wai plans to create more short films before embarking on his ambitious endeavor of directing his first feature film. Currently, he holds positions as both a Director and a Cinematographer in the advertising industry.



Wong Ga Dong The Missing Trophy



Initially embarking on his professional journey as a Quantity Surveyor in an engineering firm in Bahrain, Wong Ga Dong made the bold decision to leave his career behind to pursue his true passion for filmmaking in November 2020. His initial foray into the creative industry began as a location manager for Viu's highly popular TV series, "Keluarga Baha Don," during its second and third seasons. This experience provided Wong Ga Dong with a valuable opportunity to study and observe the dynamics of the local film industry. He made his directorial debut with a short film titled "AhMade" for

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the prestigious Petronas Kancil Awards in 2022, which went on to win a Gold award. "AhMade" showcases Wong Ga Dong's talent for creatively written comedy, with an absurdist and farcical touch that draws inspiration from Thai and Japanese storytelling.

In early 2023, Wong Ga Dong joined Another Planet Films as a junior director, taking on exciting new projects under their banner with his most recent directorial endeavour, "The Missing Trophy" for the BMW Shorties 2023 competition. Like his previous works, this short film is heavily influenced by his personal experiences, offering a glimpse into real-life situations.

With grand aspirations, Wong Ga Dong dreams of becoming a filmmaker who tells untold stories rooted in rich Malay/Javanese landscapes. He aims to shed light on the current issues faced by Malaysians, combining them with the essence of Nusantara music. He firmly believes that such narratives are what the world is yearning for, and he aspires to share these captivating stories with a global audience.

Bryan Sim The Known Stranger



Bryan Sim has experiences in crafting content across the Greater China and Southeast Asian region, and has worked on a diverse range of projects, spanning from television programs to reality shows and commercials. Driven by an intense passion for design, photography and film, Bryan's journey has taken him to different countries to explore and learn about various cultures. Along the way, he has had the privilege of collaborating with world-class talents such as Sophie Marceau and David Beckham, experiences that have shaped him into the accomplished filmmaker he is today.

As a natural storyteller, Bryan captivates audiences by skillfully blending cinematic visuals with heartfelt human emotions. Faizal Noar SELALU ADA






Ikram Haizammuri All Who Leave Go There


Putra Adib Selamat Malam, Dunia!


